Chairman's Letter to AIR Members

With Easter coming early this year it seems to have thrown all our plans into confusion. Other external groups and charities have moved their activity dates forward and clashes have inevitably occurred. All I can say is 'make your choice and keep enjoying your activities whatever they are'. To add further confusion Thursday 2nd May 2024 seems to be a date for the forthcoming local elections, therefore we may not be able to conduct our normal AIR activities as some venues may be used as voting stations on that day and will not be available. Please monitor the situation nearer that time to ensure we do not clash. We have made enquiries to Cheshire East Council as to whether the Macclesfield Community Centre will be used for this purpose and shall confirm when a response is received. On the subject of voting, please don't forget that we all need to take identification to enable your vote to be registered.

Our next coffee morning will be held at the Macclesfield Community Centre on 6th April 2024 commencing at 10:00am. and will feature a brass band trio for your entertainment These free bi-monthly events are friendly and social, proving very popular and donations collected are given to East Cheshire Hospice.

We are in discussions with Cheshire East Council regarding an increase in rental charges for the MCC. This is our main venue for activities and a rental increase is inevitable due to increased utility and maintenance costs, and also the costs have remained static for some years which has obviously been to our advantage. People living in the area must also be aware that CEC are in some financial difficulties, but they continue to recognise the important impact AIR has within the community.

The Management Committee are still endeavouring to move AIR funds into a new charities account. This will provide increased interest returns on monies that previously were sitting idle with very little interest. This can only be achieved by using a recognised 'charities account' which offers no risk to our capital and setting up the account is carefully controlled.

We continue to seek additional people for the role of trustee. The trustees carry out a valuable and necessary role to ensure the Management Committee runs the charity within the AIR Constitution and the rules of the Charity Commission. These positions must be maintained in order to satisfy charity operational requirements. Additionally, other committee and activity leadership roles are available, so if you feel that you can spend a little time supporting AIR then please contact myself, or any committee member.

Reports of the initial meeting of the pilates class suggest that it is very popular and it was over-subscribed. Details have now been circulated regarding a way forward to control numbers with two classes (mat based and chair based) being proposed. The dates are governed by the outside volunteer leader and we are working around her availability. I would again remind members with computer access that our website (https://airmacclesfield.com) has been updated and overhauled, and that all current AIR Documents and newsletters are available for perusal.

Interest has been expressed in providing a First Aid course for our leaders and members. Although no details are available yet, if you are interested please contact me, so we can ascertain the viability of this.

We all look forward to your continued enjoyment of the many activities offered by AIR and welcome any comments and correspondence from AIR members and also your aspirations for the future.
