Our annual Leaders Meeting was held on Wednesday17th July 2024 unfortunately this was poorly attended. Those that attended gave positive reports regarding the numbers for each activity and the minutes of the meeting are attached to this newsletter. The committee are considering asking those leaders that cannot attend to provide a short report beforehand, so this can be read out and then we can have a better understanding of all the AIR activities.
